The coloured area runs to all four paper edges.

Print at 100% scale, then measure the white border it leaves.

That border is your printer's hardware margin - the area it physically cannot reach. The dashed rings are measured from the paper edge at 3, 5, 10 and 15 mm to read it off directly.

No white border at all means true borderless printing.

Most office lasers leave 4-5 mm; many inkjets manage 3 mm, and a bottom edge margin larger than the others is normal - that is the paper-feed grippers, not a fault.
